E3 Camp's Expectation Form

All E3 campers are responsible for adhering to the guidelines, practices, procedures, and of E3 Camp (Empowering Excellence thru Exploration Camp).

- Campers are expected to contribute to a safe camp environment, using respectful language and appropriate physical behavior.
- Disrespectful, abusive language will not be tolerated (No profanity, racial slurs, or put downs).
- One person should talk at a time, any private conversations should be taken outside or deferred, and smart phones should be turned off (texting and emailing should not occur during the camp).
- Campers are expected to function in a group setting in a positive and cooperative manner that displays tolerance and respect for self and others.
- Refrain from disruptive or disrespectful conduct during others' presentations
- Do not touch other camper's belongings and use resources wisely.
- Do not damage or deface camp facilities or property.
- Campers are expected to follow instructions from counselors and refrain from behaviors that pose a risk to self or others.
- Campers are expected to maintain a positive attitude when participating in activities with their group.
- Value a diversity of views and opinions.
- Respect authority.
- NO weapons are tolerated nor allowed during camp or at any camp activities or at any facilities where camp is held.
